“PALM SUNDAY”

FIRST READING :-A reading from the book of Isaiah 50:4-7

Isaiah tells us how Jesus, the servant of Yahweh, would obey his Father; how he would not refuse suffering. In his suffering Jesus would put all his trust in his Father who loved him and who would glorify him at his resurrection.

RESPONSE :- My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?

SECOND READING : -A reading from the letter of St. Paul to the Philippians 2:6-11

St. Paul tells the Christians at Phillipi, how Jesus came down from heaven to earth, saved us and went back to his Father.

GOSPEL :- The Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ according to St. Luke 22:14-23,56

Today's passion reading gives us an insight into the final moments of Jesus' life, his suffering, crucifixion death and burial

REFLECTION:

Jesus Christ was not the first man to die for a cause, nor the last. He was not the first or the last innocent man to be put to death. He was not the only one ever crucified. There were on that same day two others. Even as regards physical pain it is at least possible that others have suffered as much. What then makes the Passion so different? And it is undeniably different.

The passion narrative, even though we have heard and reflected on a number of times, still affects us. We wonder why? The answer lies in the completely human and utterly shabby circumstances in which Christ died.

Take for example the behaviour of his friends. Was there ever such a complete let-down? One could almost stomach the betrayal of Judas, had the other eleven remained faithful. But one short line tells their story “And they all forsook him and fled.” And these were his friends, his only friends. And not one of them lifted a finger for him.

What has this story to do with us? It is the story of our salvation. There isn't a part in the whole sordid script that we would not play to perfection. Peter in his pride and Peter in his fall and Peter in his repentance too. We'd fit in perfectly with the disciples who fled at the first sign of danger, or with Caiaphas and the high priests, with their self-righteousness and eagerness to reform others while ignoring themselves, or with Pilate in

his abuse of authority, or with the mob with its thirst for excitement and blood. And Judas? Let's face it - there's a Judas in all of us. There are times and situations in all our lives when Jesus could easily say to us as he said to Judas, “Friend, why are you here?” The truth is, it was only his friends who could really have crucified him so.

CHRISM MASS:

As is the custom in our Archdiocese, the Chrism Mass will be celebrated on Tuesday of the Holy Week at 6.30 pm. During this Mass, the Holy Oils will be blessed; also the new Extra-ordinary Ministers of Holy Communion will be commissioned. As usual, on that day, an orientation programme will be held for the Eucharistic Ministers at 4 pm at the DCC Hall.

On Wednesday, the 27th of March, priests will be available for confession from 5 pm onwards. Kindly make use of this opportunity. (Please do not come for confession on other days as priests will not be available).

EXAMS FOR CATECHISM CHILDREN:

The Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Communion will be conferred on our children in the month of July. To become eligible, it is necessary that they come regularly for the Classes and also pass the exams which will be held on Sunday, the 14th of April, 2013. Annual Day of the Catechism children will be held on the 5th of May, 2013.

ECUMENICAL STATIONS OF THE CROSS :

As part of the Year of Faith, the Archdiocese is organizing an Ecumenical Stations of the Cross this afternoon. It will begin from St. Mary's Church, Old Delhi at 2.30 pm and will conclude at the Cathedral. In addition to strengthening the ecumenical spirit among Christians, it will be a great witness as well as a good preparation for the Paschal Triduum. We encourage you to participate in it in large numbers.
