"19TH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR"

FIRST READING:-A reading from the first Book of Isaiah (55:1-3)

In this passage the author refers to the events of the Exodus, "that night", in which God showed His mighty power to save His chosen people from their cruel enemies to prove that the Israelites were dear to Him.

RESPONSE:- Happy are the people the Lord has chosen as his own.

SECOND READING: - A reading from the Letter of St. Paul to the Romans (8:35, 37-39)

The basis of the faith of the ancestors of the Jewish people is the assurance of God's fidelity to His promises. It is only faith that can please God.

GOSPEL:- A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St Luke (12:32-48)

In a few vivid and expressive similes, Jesus tells the disciples how they should conduct their lives on earth so that they may always be found in God's friendship when their call to judgement comes; we must always be prepared.

REFLECTION:

Human life is characterised by uncertainties. We cannot be sure of what will happen today or in the future. In spite of our meticulous planning for the future, the future could take a totally different direction. A serious and mature reflection will make us aware that these uncertainties and mysteriousness give a better orientation to human life. While certainty destroys initiatives, uncertainty gives enthusiasm to life; while certainty rules out hope, uncertainty always looks forward with hope; while certainty leaves no place for God, uncertainty brings us closer to God. Uncertainty and mysteriousness of life prompt us to be always ready because the "Son of Man is coming at an unexpected hour." While the second reading of today indicates Abraham as a model of a man prepared for the unexpected, the gospel offers certain suggestions so as to be always ready. One of the ways to be ready is to become aware that our life will not last forever and that any moment from now could be the last. This awareness should give more urgency and seriousness to our life. Another means proposed is to use the gifts of God for the purpose for which they are destined. At this juncture, it would be good to remember that almost every evil in this world has its beginning in the abuse of the gifts of God by human beings. Finally, readiness to meet the Son of Man entails faithful service.

Every state of life imposes precise responsibilities and particular services. We must serve because by nature and by vocation, we are always servants.
