REFLECTIONS FOR THIS SUNDAY

4TH SUNDAY OF LENT

FIRST READING:- A reading from the First Book of Samuel (16:1.6-7, 10-13)

Samuel privately anoints David, a shepherd boy of Bethlehem, the least of Jesse's sons, to be the king of Israel. While people look at appearances, God looks at the heart.

RESPONSE:- The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want. SECOND READING: - A reading from the Letter of St. Paul to the **Ephesians (5:8-14)**

St. Paul tells the Ephesians to examine their lifestyl. He urges them to give up the works of darkness and live like the children of light.

GOSPEL: - A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St. John (9:1, 6-9, 13-17, 34-41)

In this passage St John narrates the responses of the neighbours, the parents and the Pharisees to the healing of the man born blind.



REFLECTION:

The story about the man born blind is about seeing the deeper realities of our everyday life and Jesus the Saviour. The man formerly blind had no idea his ophthalmologist was the Messiah. The most famous blind man in history has a lot to teach us about opening our eyes and seeing things anew or differently. Our modern world has a particular form of blindness. We have microscopes to see things very small and telescopes to see distant objects, but often we do not see what is closest to us. We live in a strange time. We know more about celebrities than we do about next door neighbours - or even those we call "family" and "friends". So many things distract us from what really matters.

Blessed Mother Teresa once said: "I think the world today is upside down.... We have no time for our children, we have no time for each other; there is no time to enjoy each other. In the home begins the disruption of the peace of the world".

This Sunday we ask Jesus to heal our blindness, particularly our failure to see those close to us. Help us to see our own children, our family members, our fellow parishioners. It is terrible to not see those close to us, but there is an even worse form of blindness: the failure to see Jesus. The man born blind has a lot to teach us, because no matter who we are, or our years of Christian discipleship, there are always areas of darkness and blindness in our lives that we are called to leave behind, to embrace the light which God offers us.
