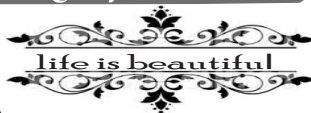

1st Reading: Neh 8: 2-6, 8-10

This passage gives a graphic picture of the solemn reading of the word of God in the hearing of all the people. The ceremony is so touching that the people weep but Ezra and companions console the people and send them on their way.

2nd Reading: 1 Corth 12: 12-30

Paul corrects the misunderstanding in the Corinthian community regarding the spiritual gifts. He brings in the metaphor of the human body to explain the phenomenon.

Gospel: Lk 1: 1-4; 4: 14-21

Luke dedicates his book to Theophilus in order to strengthen his faith. After the dedication, Luke describes Jesus' action in the native synagogue.

REFLECTION

In today's gospel St. Luke tells us that Christ is the Lord, Christ is the Teacher and the friend. **Christ the Lord:** Here we have Jesus' first sermon. He reads a passage from the Old Testament that refers to the Messiah, to the descendent of David whom God promised to raise up to establish a Kingdom of justice and peace that would never end. Jesus made clear what exactly it was he wanted them to believe – that he is the Lord. **Christ the Teacher:** Here St. Luke begins his description of Jesus' public ministry. Jesus will spend the coming two or three years traveling throughout Palestine, teaching, healing, and gathering his Twelve Apostles, whom he will put in charge of the Church after his passion, resurrection, and ascension. He wants to bring his truth what he taught and his grace to every human heart. **Christ the Friend:** Jesus came to bring “good news” to those who suffer, to free captives and to cure the blind – he came because we needed him to come. He came to be our Savior. He is all for us, the perfect friend, the one we can trust without limits.

आज के सुसमाचार में संत लुकस हम लोगों से कहते हैं कि ईसा प्रभु हैं, ईसा गुरु एवं मित्र हैं। ईसा प्रभु-यहाँ हम ईसा के पहला उपदेश सुनते हैं। उन्होंने पुराने व्यवस्थान से एक अनुच्छेद पढ़ा, जहाँ मसीह का उल्लेख है, दाउद के वंश का, जिसमें ईश्वर ने एक न्याय और शांति के राज्य को स्थापित करने की प्रतिज्ञा की थी। जिसका कभी अंत नहीं होगा। ईसा साफ कहते हैं कि वास्तव में यह था कि वही प्रभु हैं, जिसे वह चाहते थे कि लोग उन पर विश्वास करें। ईसा गुरु-यहाँ संत लुकस ईसा द्वारा लोगों की सेवा की शुरुआत की विवरण को दर्शाते हैं। ईसा दो-तीन साल पूरे फिलिप्पी की यात्रा के दौरान, शिक्षा देते हुए, चंगाई करते हुए, तथा बारह शिष्यों को एकत्रित करते हुए अपना समय व्यतीत किया जिन्हें वे अपने दुःखभोग, पुनरुत्थान, एवं स्वर्गारोहण के बाद कलीसिया का प्रभारी नियुक्त करेंगे। उन्होंने क्या शिक्षा दिया एवं प्रत्येक जन के हृदय में अपनी अनुग्रह की सच्चाई को लाना चाहते थे। ईसा मित्र-ईसा शुभ संदेश लेकर आए, दरिद्रों को सुसमाचार सुनाने, बंदियों को मुक्त करने एवं अंधों को दृष्टिदान का संदेश लेकर आए। वे आए क्योंकि हमें उनके आने की जरूरत थी। वह हमारा मुक्तिदाता बनकर आए। वह हमारे लिए सबकुछ हैं, उत्तम मित्र, एक जिसपर हम असीमित विश्वास कर सकते हैं।

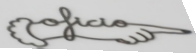
