## REFLECTION

Mission needs ongoing formation

How can we bring the message of Jesus to this everchanging world? This requires continuous reflection and formation of all people called to this missionary apostolate. We need to become familiar with the language and the culture of the people today.

In his first apostolic letter 'Evangelii Gaudium', Pope Francis gave the church some guidelines.

1. All Christian formation consists of entering more deeply into the kerygma.... The first proclamation must ring out over and over: "Jesus Christ loves you; he gave his life to save you; and now he is living at your side every day to enlighten, strengthen and free you".(Evangelii Gaudium 165).
2. Whenever we make the effort to return to the source and to recover the original freshness of the Gospel, new avenues arise, new paths of creativity open up, with different forms of expression, more eloquent signs and words with new meaning for today's world (EG 11).
3. An evangelizing community gets involved by word and deed in people's daily lives... It embraces human life, touching the suffering flesh of Christ in others. Evangelizers take on the "smell of the sheep". (EG 24).
4. Today's vast and rapid cultural changes demand that we constantly seek ways of expressing unchanging truths in a language which brings out their abiding newness. (EG 41).
5. "Before all else, the Gospel invites us to respond to the God of love who save us, to see God in others and to go forth from ourselves to seek the good of others (EG 39).
6. "Whenever we encounter another person in love, we learn something new about God." (EG 272).

Son Jesus Christ rose from the dead,

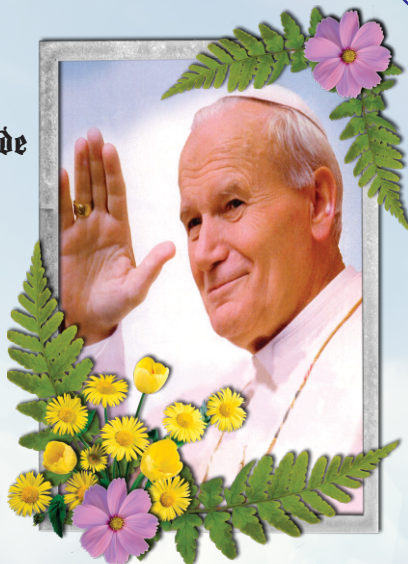
he commissioned his followers to "go and make disciples of all nations" and you remind us that
