

REFLECTIONS FOR THIS SUNDAY

“4TH SUNDAY OF ADVENT”

FIRST READING:-A reading from the Book of Isaiah (7:10-14)

This passage, from Isaiah, is one of his most descriptive and definitive prophecies about the coming of the future messianic King, the Christ. He speaks about a young woman and a son, who will be called Emmanuel, that is 'God-With-us'

RESPONSE :- Let the Lord enter! He is the king of glory.

SECOND READING: - A reading from the Letter of St. Paul to the Romans (1:1-7)

The opening words of the Letter to the Romans draw attention to the human and divine 'roots' of Jesus. In it, St. Paul calls himself a servant of Jesus Christ, and an Apostle set apart to preach the Gospel.

GOSPEL :- A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St. Mathew (1:18-24)

St. Matthew shows that the birth of Christ from a virgin, without a human father, was the fulfilment of Isaiah's prophecy, made seven centuries before his birth.

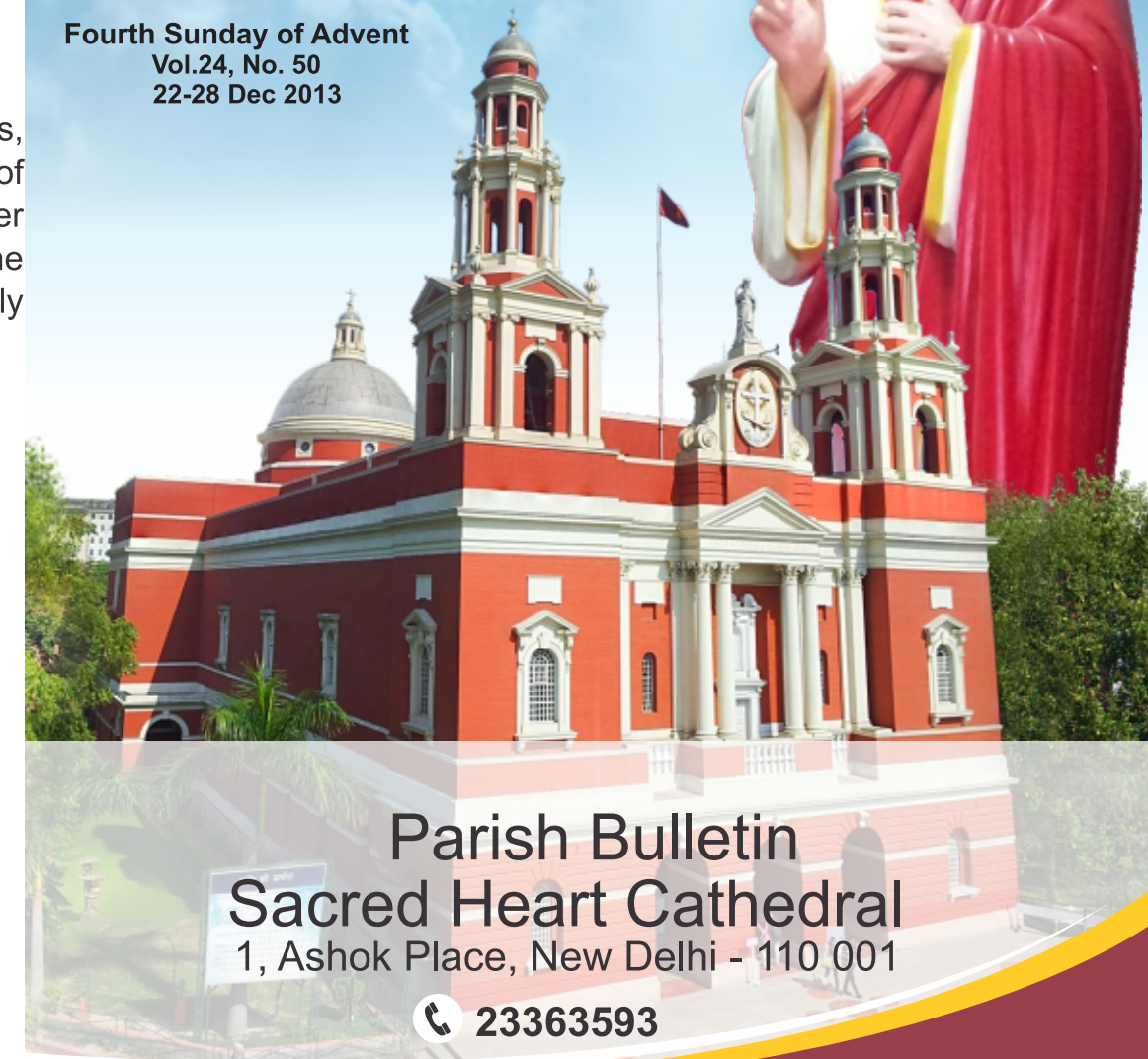

REFLECTION:

Prayer is a personal relationship with God. In this personal relationship, there is nothing that God will not grant to the person in relationship with God. Jesus tells us “ If you remain in me and my words remain in you, you may ask whatever you want and it will be given to you” (Jn 15: 7). Joseph was really troubled, confused and lost. All his dreams about his life are shattered and in this predicament he had none other than God to turn to. He discovers that his wife-to-be is pregnant and he being a just man does not want her to be exposed to the dictates of the law. It appears that he does not want to do anything in a hurry, confusion or anger. And so Joseph decides to take this disturbing matter to God in prayer. God in turn blesses him with a dream in which he reveals his plan and assures Joseph that it is by the Holy Spirit that Mary has conceived and the child to be born is the promise of God being fulfilled. God answers the prayers of Joseph and rewards his faith by blessing him with a unique role in the salvation history of mankind. Like Mary, Joseph is the model of faith for us. He remains a contradiction and a challenge to our time. Today's generation has become so intolerant, and acts on impulse. Nobody loses a chance to label, condemn and expose a person who has done wrong in their perspective. Hardly anyone takes time today to understand and learn what made the other do what or why he/she did in his/her life. Joseph took time to discern.
