

REFLECTIONS FOR THIS SUNDAY

5TH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR:

FIRST READING:- A reading from the Book of Isaiah (58:7-10)

Prophet Isaiah tells his fellow -Jews that God commands them to practise charity towards their needy neighbours. It is only by doing so, they can prove their love and loyalty to God.

RESPONSE :- Praise the Lord who heals the broken-hearted.

SECOND READING: - A reading from the First Letter of St. Paul to the Corinthians (2:1-5)

St. Paul tells his Corinthian converts, that his success was not due to any of his merits but to the Spirit and the power of God, which was made manifest among them.

GOSPEL :-A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St. Mathew (5:13-16)

Christ calls his followers the 'Salt of the earth' and the 'Light of the World'. Thus Christ puts his followers on the same level as himself.



REFLECTION:

Light is the key word that we find in the first and third readings of today. In the second reading Paul, from his own experience enlightens us that real light does not come from ‘wise’ reasoning and clever sophistry but from the cross of Jesus. The light which comes from the cross and shines in our lives should lead us to those people among us who are ‘hungry’, ‘afflicted’, and ‘homeless’, in order to be in the presence of ‘Jesus Christ and Him crucified’ who came as light to dispel darkness.

The function of light is to shine, to illumine. The light of faith which we have received is not to be kept hidden but to shine and spread around. Just like light which illumines, guides, and gives warmth, just like salt which purifies, preserves and gives taste our Christian life is meant to enkindle the goodness in others and promote its growth.

“As light, we are to provide illumination so that the talents and hopes of others can be seen and acted upon. As the light of our families and neighbourhoods, of our parishes and religious communities, we are to speak and act in such a way that people do not crash into one another with anger and spiteful words - as Isaiah wrote, with ‘false accusations and malicious speech’.

In short we are to be always instruments of peace, warmth, love, trust, confidence, respect, dignity, care and concern.

Pope`s Message for the 22nd World Day of the Sick

The Holy Father in his message to mark the occasion, turns his attention to the sick and all those who provide them with care and treatment. He begins by reminding those who are afflicted that the “the Church sees the special presence of the suffering Christ in them and that God gives us the courage to face each adversity with him and united to Him.

The Holy Father then underscores the importance of the role of the Son of God made man in the life of those who suffer, explaining that his very nature has the power to transform and reduce human disease by taking it on himself, saying that’s why suffering no longer has the last word.

In the third part of his message the Pope exhorts us to approach those who are in need of care with tenderness.

The holy father concludes his message by reflecting on the figure of St. John, the disciple who was with Mary at the foot of the cross. It is this saint, he stresses, that takes us back to the source of faith and charity, (the theme chosen this year) to the heart of God who is love and he reminds us that we cannot love God if we do not love our neighbour.
